

Erickson leads the named ballot

- By 47.1% to 39.6% (R+7), Mike Erickson leads Andrea Salinas
- NAV/Independent voters pick Erickson by +10



Inflation is driving the narrative

- 30% of voters say inflation is their top priority, up from 22% at the beginning of June
- It is by far the top issue with college-educated voters and middle- to lower-propensity voters
- NAV/Independent voters look like Republican voters who care much more about inflation than other issues like abortion

The political environment leans Republican in Oregon's newest congressional district

- Thanks to a generic ballot that shows women tied (44% Dem / 43% GOP), Republican Mike Erickson starts with a strong foundation
- Joe **Biden** has an **abysmal 40% favorability** rating in the district; this is driven strongly by younger voters under the age of 50

METHODOLOGY: This survey was conducted July 26 – 28, 2022, with 400 likely general election voters. It has a margin of error of $\pm 4.89\%$.
